This 16-hour course will be presented by experienced DRE Instructors from around the state. It introduces law enforcement officers to the Drug Recognition Expert program and gives them the tools they need to recognize a drug impaired driver and understand the roles and responsibilities of a DRE.

This class **does not** qualify an officer to be a DRE.

All students attending this course **must be proficient** in administering Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and be able to successfully complete a proficiency examination or they will not be allowed to complete the course.

This course qualifies for 16 hours of POST credit,
in the area of Technical Studies.
